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All the data in the reports are from government sources: Bureau of the Census, Bureau of Labor Statistics, and the Federal Housing Finance Agency. The home price forecasts, the data analyses, and the various conclusions drawn from the data are my own.

The reports are updated every quarter, right after new home price data for metro areas is published by the FHFA. The zip code data are updated on an uncertain schedule. Home price data usually are available in the spring, the other data in the fall.
